## The App with the individual child at the centre

If you are interested in bringing a safe, multi-modal child documentation system to your early childhood service, that meets quality standards in early education and keeps the child at the centre of your practice- then read on!

#### What is MOSAIC Educator?

'MOSAIC Educator' is an inclusive, secure, child documentation system on a cloud-based app designed for use in early childhood services. Over time, it allows educators to build **a beautiful portrait of early learning** for each individual child.

Supporting an **emergent**, **strengths-based approach**, the MOSAIC app contains a range of **pedagogical tools** to support the work of the professional educator. Designed as an electronic storybook (**digital portfolio**) unique to each child, MOSAIC is a multi-modal documentation framework for **assessment for learning**, **emergent planning and daily recording responsibilities**, **all whilst keeping the child at the centre**.

Through the interconnecting 'MOSAIC Family' App, the early childhood service and nominated family members can access regular updates in the form of photographs, videos, learning stories and reports. For children under 3, daily care records are also communicated directly to a parent's phone or tablet in real time.

The Daily Record section contains a 'Daily Care Log', 'Safe Sleep Check' for the under 3's and an 'Attendance Register' for each room.




This section contains a range of pedagogical tools - emergent planning templates, group learning story templates and parent engagement statistics.

#### MOSAIC is an educator tool that supports quality pedagogical practice



MOSAIC is framed around a **strength based**, **child-led pedagogical approach** that sees the child as a unique individual with **a right to participate**.

**The Learning Story Approach** to early childhood assessment **for** learning is used to frame Aistear's themes, aims, goals and dispositions.

The uniquely designed functions in MOSAIC allows the Educator to compile a beautiful **electronic storybook** for each child. Learning stories are easily linked to our **emergent curriculum planning templates** for different age groups based on children's interests and needs.

Each child's e-storybook is **personal to them** with a personal photo and video gallery. It is designed to contain the necessary daily records including attendance, personal care, and sleep checks.

**The child's voice, interests, strengths and learning** are presented through engaging learning updates, videos and pictures. Each learning story template is pre-loaded with the appropriate curriculum learning goals, positive learning dispositions and a plan for learning. The app also contains messaging functions, personal information storage for each child and a group news function.

#### WHAT QUALITY INDICATORS ARE DEMONSTRATED BY THIS BRIEF MOSAIC LEARNING STORY?


- The educator is skilled and in-tune with Macey;

### **MOSAIC Family App (Parent App)**

'MOSAIC Family' is a separate App that links to 'MOSAIC Educator' so that parents and approved family members can view and keep up to date with their child's learning and development achievements as they happen via their phone or tablet. As updates will be received in 'real time', this enables parents and family to reinforce learning and celebrate achievements to build confidence, self-esteem and nurture further learning.

In addition, for children under 3 years old (or children with additional needs), parents will receive a Daily Care Log and a Sleep Check Log to inform them of what the child ate, drank, sleep times, nappy changes, mood etc. so that they are fully connected to their child's physical and emotional care each day.

Parents can access their child/rens individual Storybook(s) by subscribing annually to the MOSAIC Family App for either Android or iOS (Apple) devices.
