

Child-led Documentation Training Programme



‘Connecting Observation, Learning Stories and Emergent Planning’

This is a **two-session programme** that will enable meaningful child documentation and emergent planning across the whole early childhood setting.

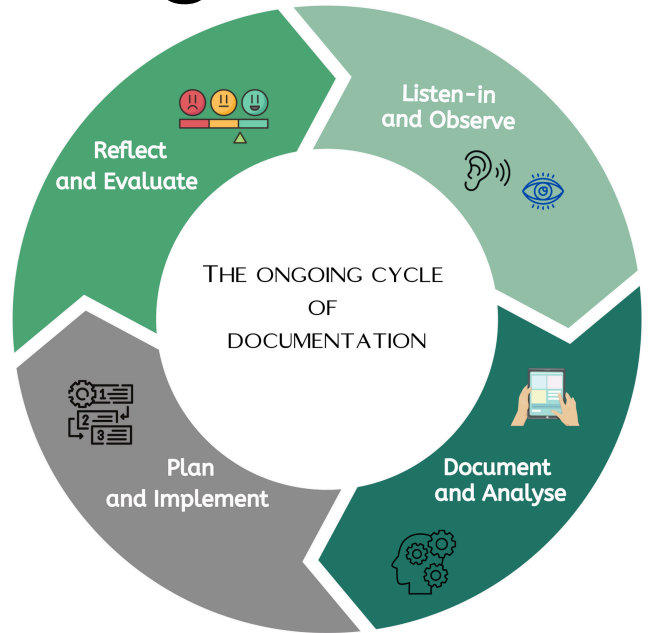
Session 1

Documenting Progression in Learning

This session will enable educators to **see the individual child** and understand how to tune in to and **document learning** in a way that meaningfully demonstrates **progression in learning**. The **Learning Story** technique is demonstrated and samples provided. Educators will learn different techniques and strategies to include child voice and participation in the documentation process and how to **connect this to emergent planning**. Using **Wall Mapping** and **Living Wall Documentation** as a reflection tool is explored.

Planning in the Moment

This session will connect the learning from session 1 to expand into **emergent curriculum planning**. The **long, medium and short term strategy** is explained. The format of a broad-based emergent plan in line with Aistear is demonstrated. Educators will learn how to blend child interests with **one flexible emergent plan that suits all ages**. A sample **Curriculum Statement and Planning Framework** are provided **FREE** as part of session 2.
