

Documenting Progression in Learning Session 1

This session will enable educators to see the individual child and understand how to tunein to and document progression in learning in line with Aistear 2024. The Learning Story technique is demonstrated and samples are provided. Educators will learn different techniques and strategies to include child voice and participation in the assessment process and how to connect this to emergent planning. Using Living Wall Documentation as a child participation activity and a reflection tool is explored.

Session 2 connects the learning from session 1 to expand into emergent curriculum planning through continuous provision.
