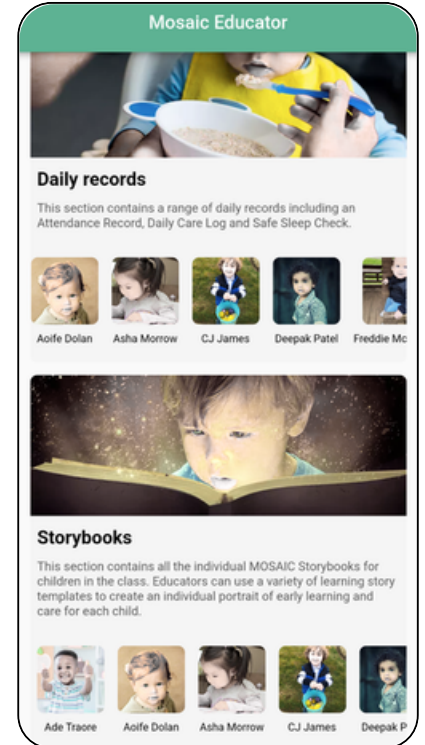
If you are interested in bringing a safe, pedagogical documentation system to your early childhood service, that meets quality standards in early education and keeps the child at the centre of your practice- then read on!

What is MOSAIC Educator?

'MOSAIC Educator' is an inclusive, secure, child-led documentation system designed for use in early childhood services. Fully aligned with Aistear 2024, it allows educators to build **a beautiful e-storybook of early learning** for each individual child.

Supporting an **emergent, strengths-based approach**, the MOSAIC app contains a range of **pedagogical tools** to support the work of the agentic, professional educator. Designed as an electronic storybook (**digital portfolio**) unique to each child, MOSAIC is a multi-modal documentation framework for **assessment for learning, emergent planning and daily recording responsibilities, all whilst keeping the child at the centre.**

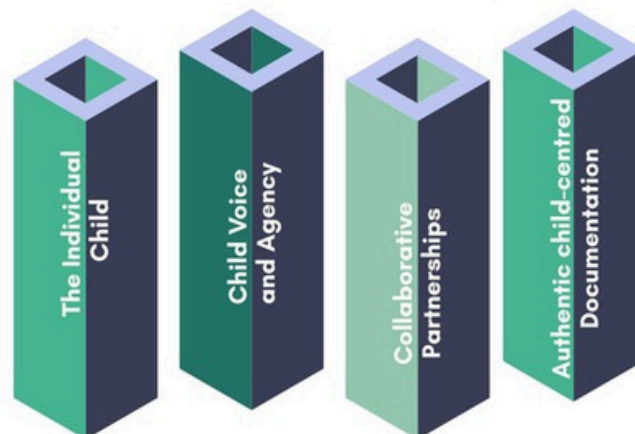
Through the interconnecting 'MOSAIC Family' App, the early childhood service and nominated family members can access regular updates in the form of photographs, videos, learning stories and reports. For children under 3, daily care records are also communicated directly to a parent's device.



MOSAIC IS THE SOLUTION TO 4 KEY CHALLENGES:

- **For the child** - an individual, strengths-based storybook of learning and development which safeguards child privacy and enables child participation;
- **For early childhood providers**, a streamlined, whole service early learning documentation system that saves precious time, resources and is evidence based for quality standards;
- **For parents and family**, secure, encrypted, real-time learning updates and partnership for learning progression;
- **For external compliance organisations**, meeting quality standards that require recording systems to be inclusive, progressive, individual to the child, and accessible to parents.

Foundational Pillars



These four pillars align with the central goal of the MOSAIC Method: tuning in to the individual child and using understanding to nurture and support wellbeing, learning and development.

The MOSAIC Educator Platform - At a Glance

Manager's Dashboard (PC/Laptop)



The **Manager's Dashboard** is where classrooms are set up, children are added/moved, documents stored, 'Messages', 'Quality Enhancement Record', 'Parent Document' Folder, Attendance/Cleaning reports printed .. and more.

Daily Records (App)



The **Daily Records** section contains a 'Daily Care Log', 'Safe Sleep Check' for the under 3's and an 'Attendance Register' for each room.

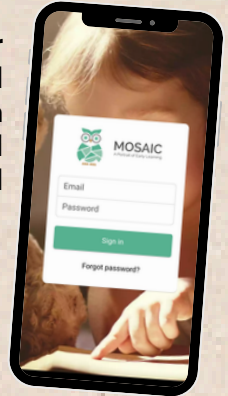

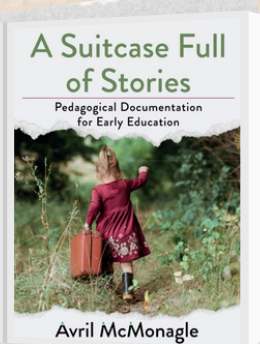
Career summary:

- One of four authors of Aistear, Ireland's first early childhood curriculum framework, during her tenure as an Education Officer with the National Council for Curriculum and Assessment.
- Lead person in the National Early Years Access Initiative, a three-year Government led initiative focusing on quality standards, which informed early childhood policy in Ireland.
- Participated in international trips to showcase Irish policy initiatives in Czech Republic, Iceland and USA.
- Spearheaded and coordinated Ireland's first national research on the Cost of Childcare which informed Government funding initiatives in Ireland.
- From 2015–2018, Avril was appointed by the Minister for Children and Youth Affairs to serve on the Council of the NCCA, contributing expertise on early childhood at the national policy level.
- As Manager of Donegal County Childcare (2008–2018), she spearheaded numerous regional and national legacy projects for quality early years education and training.
- Developed training programmes and specialised content for national programmes on early education.



In 2025, Avril became a Founding Member and recognised Thought Leader within the Global Wellbeing Education Collaborative, contributing her expertise to international initiatives focused on elevating wellbeing practices in education. This group of international leaders work together towards a shared vision *'To place holistic wellbeing at the very heart of education. Because the emotional, mental, and physical health of children, and their educators, is just as vital as academic achievement.'*



Avril is also a published author. Her latest book, *A Suitcase Full of Stories – Pedagogical Documentation for Early Education (2024)*, is available on Amazon and is used as a core text for early childhood degree programmes internationally.

Her lifelong dedication to enhancing early education is evidenced through her pioneering initiatives, policy contributions, and commitment to striving for positive life outcomes for all children.

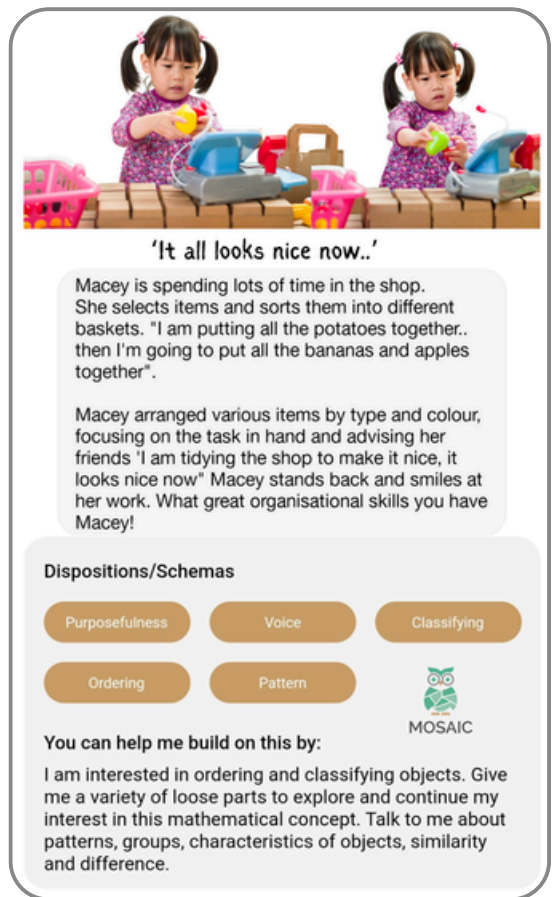
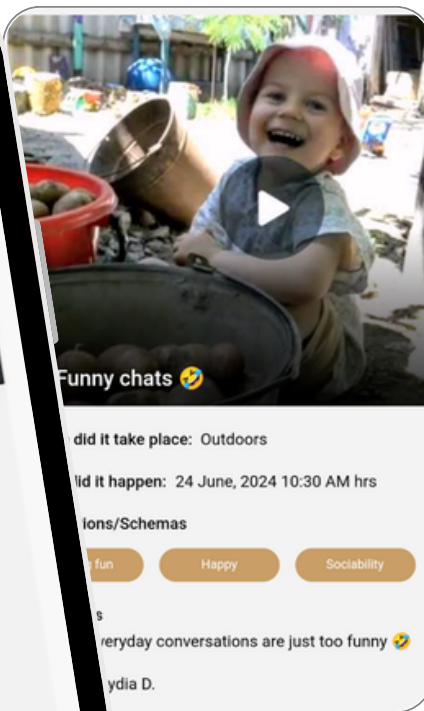
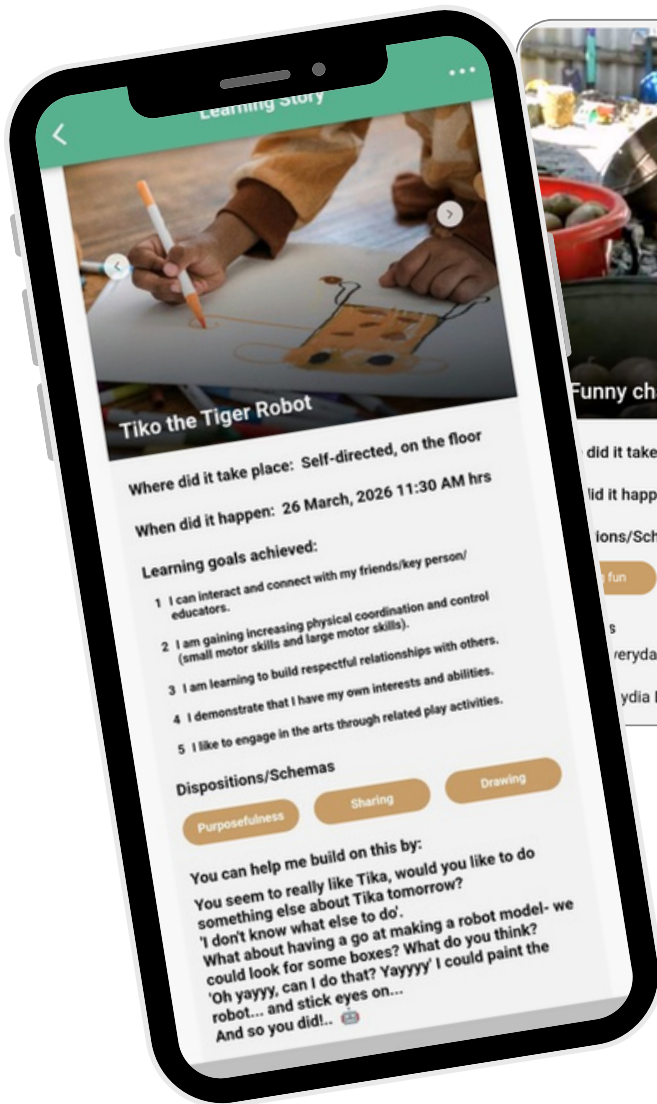

To include the child's actual voice, thoughts and choices regarding a particular area or idea.

Picture Story

To quickly capture and share a creation/interaction accompanied by a brief comment or observed disposition.

Snapshot Review:

A summary of progress and targets for a specific timeframe or an inhouse transition summary.

Group Story

To capture experiences for the whole group - use for a floor-book, display or planning evidence.

Transition Report

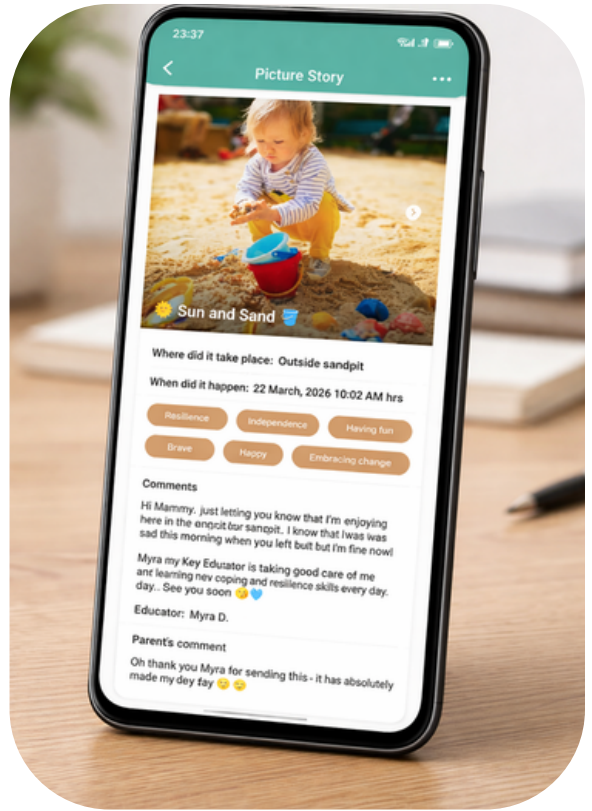
Summary of achievements so a new educator can provide consistency in learning and where the child can also have a say.

Tri-part Story

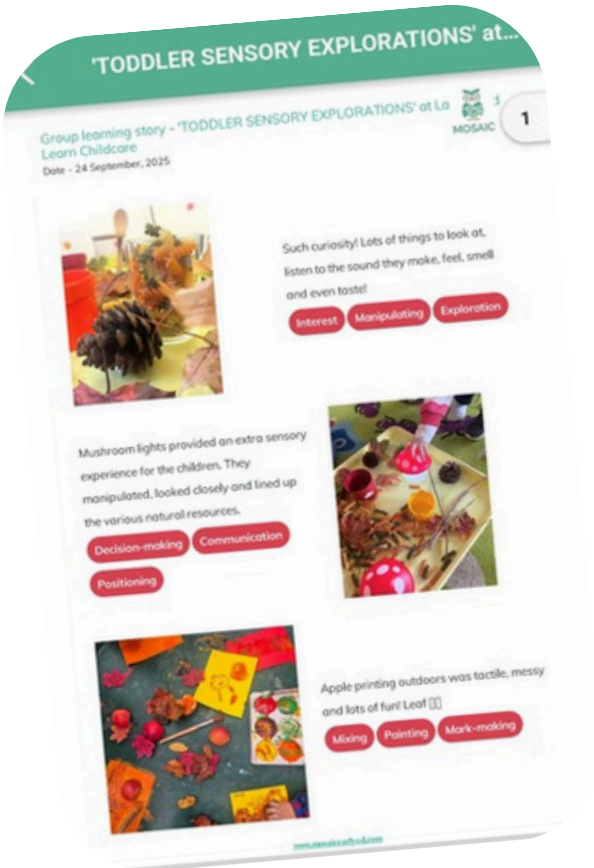
Record the early childhood curriculum learning goals achieved by the child and use this to inform a child-led curriculum plan.

Video Story

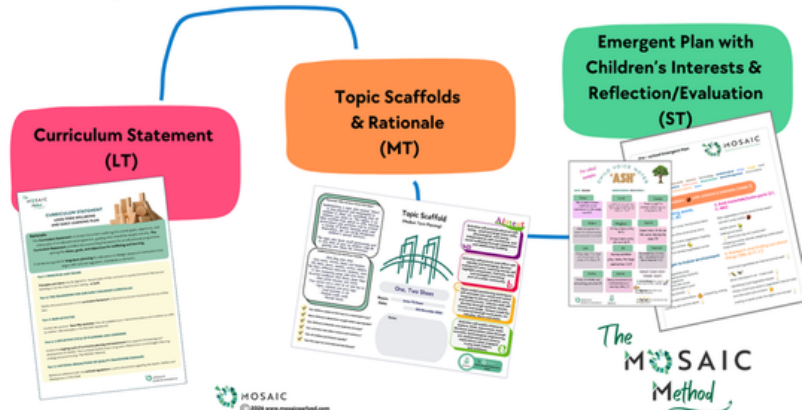
Capturing, slowing down and reflecting on children's play and learning.

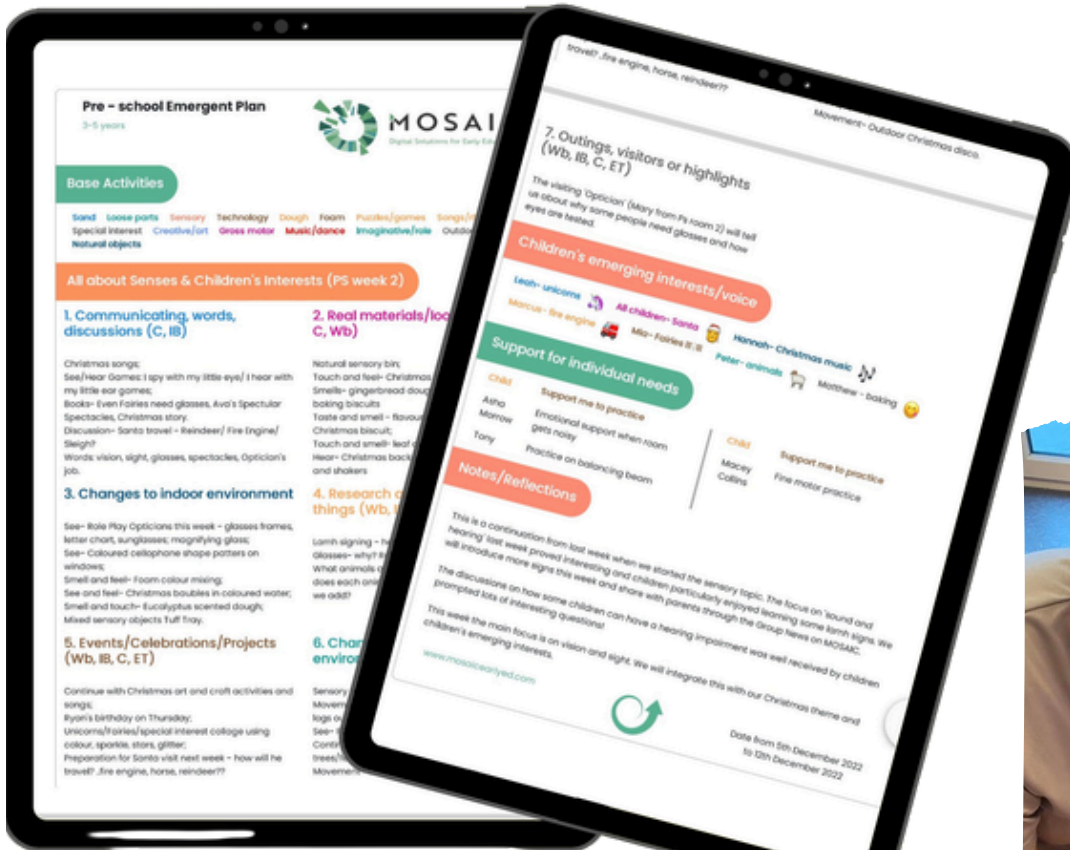
The Planning Framework - At a Glance



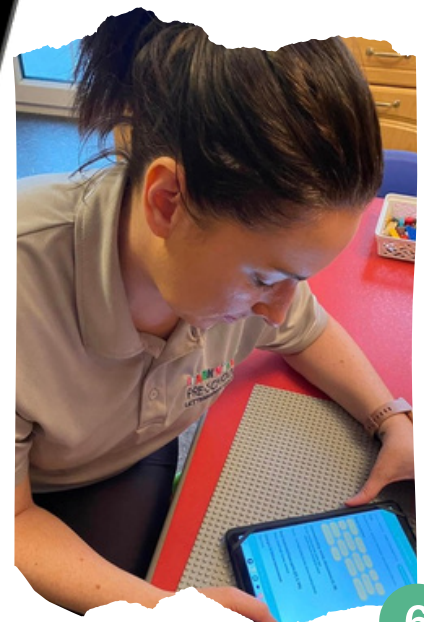


The **MOSAIC** Method

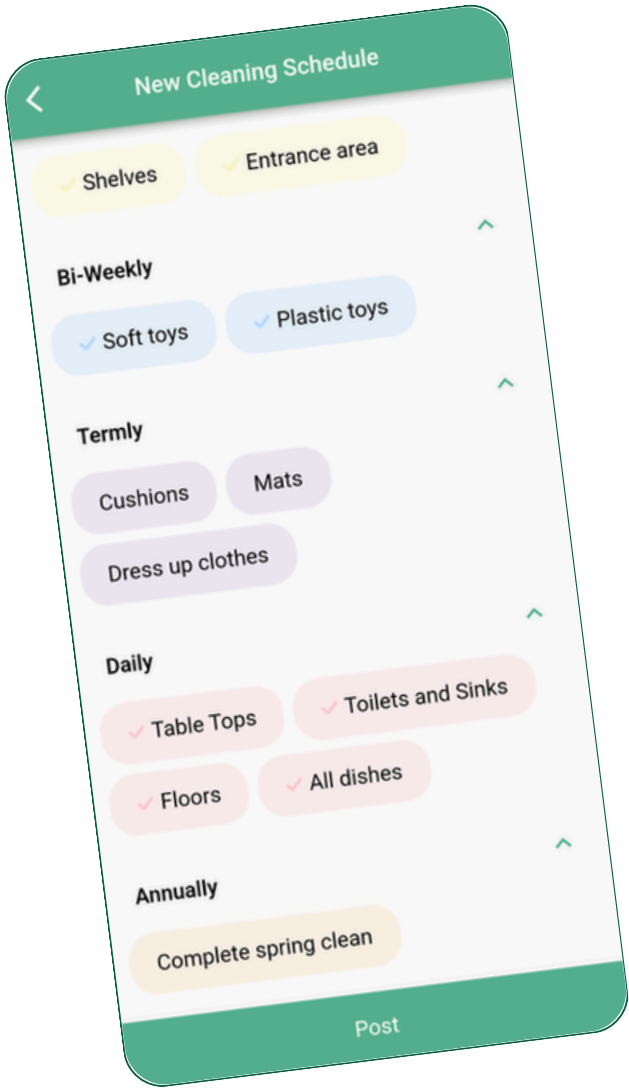


Emergent Curriculum Planning

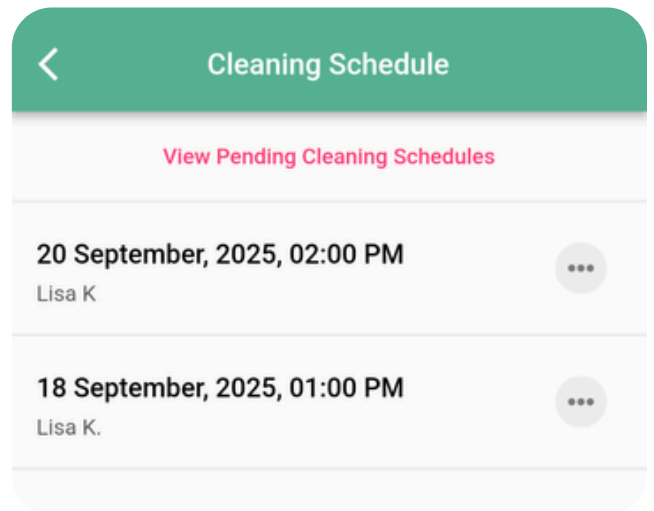

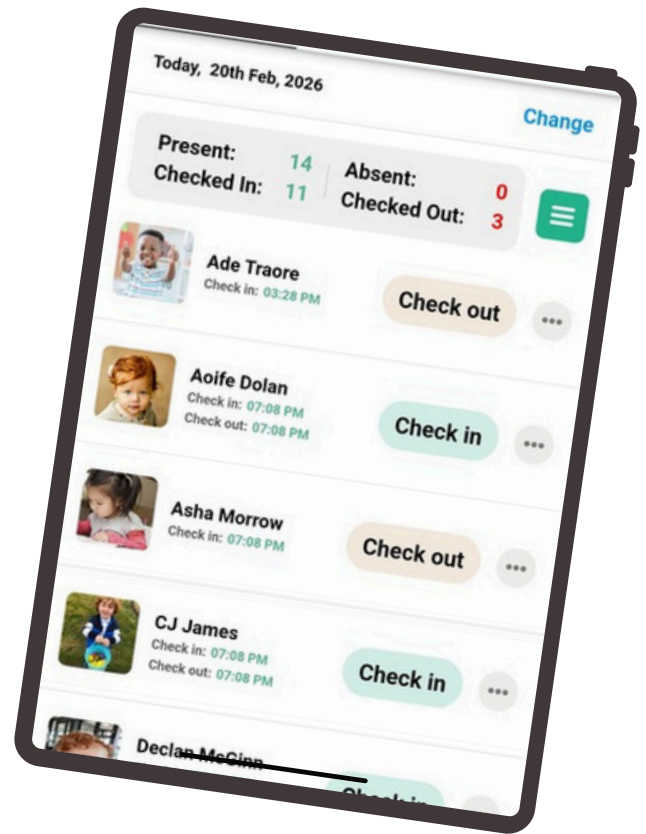

MOSAIC Family App (Parent App)

'MOSAIC Family' is a separate App that links to 'MOSAIC Educator' so that parents and approved family members can view and keep up to date with their child's learning and development achievements as they happen via their phone or tablet. As updates will be received in 'real time', this enables parents and family to reinforce learning and celebrate achievements to build confidence, self-esteem and nurture further learning. One subscription covers multiple children for the year.

In addition, for children under 3 years old (or children with additional needs), parents will receive a Daily Care Log and a Sleep Check Log to inform them of what the child ate, drank, sleep times, nappy changes, mood etc. so that they are fully connected to their child's physical and emotional care each day.

Parents can access their child/rens individual Storybook(s) by subscribing annually to the MOSAIC Family App for either Android or iOS (Apple) devices.
